Steps to Follow	The Relevant Deadlines
Online Application for Graduation	March 8th, 2021 – June 29th, 2021 * *Online Applications for Graduation end at noon (Hour: 12.00) of the last day. The publication requirement will be validated and approved by the Graduate School within the first five business days from the day of the online application (Note: If you haven't received confirmation of the graduation application within the first business days from the day of your online application, please contact the Graduate School.)
Creating accounts on turnitin.com and uploading the theses for plagiarism check	
The Graduate School checks the publication requirements and plagiarism results	
Submission of the Final Thesis to the Jury Members (First Submission)	The first three business days following the e-mail including the approval of the publication
The Submission of the Hard Copies of Theses to the Jury Members	The first week following the notification of the Jury Members designated in the Executive Board Meeting to the Department
Defense Examinations	For MSc. programs; AFTER 3 (THREE) DAYS the EARLIEST and 1 (ONE) MONTH the LATEST as of the submission of the theses to the jury members For Ph.D. programs; AFTER 15 (FIFTEEN) DAYS the EARLIEST and 1 (ONE) MONTH the LATEST as of the submission of the theses to the jury members The defense examinations must be carried out within the time intervals stated above.
Uploading the Theses Accepted in the defense exams onto www.turnitin.com	During the following 3 (three) weeks after the Thesis Defence Exam
Format Check of the Theses by the Graduate School	
Final Submission of the Theses to the Graduate School	During the following month after the Defense Exam

* Online Applications for graduation start at the midnight (00.00 hours) on the first day and finish at the noon (12.00 hours) of the last day.
